





Diagram 20 — Alarm system


Anything I cannot find in the manual and it does not have everything I can find on the internet. For the most part it has the information in it. I would recommend this to anyone interested in doing their maintenance and repairs themselves. Haynes books are not as detailed as shop manuals. For the DIY person it works. I had gone to AZone to look at their manuals and those were the 1993 edition of this manual if the book is sealed with plastic but pages are yellowed, chances are its an old edition, trust me on that one. The AZone version was published about 18 years ago and its just not up to date enough to cover todays do it yourself repairs, which have come a long way with recharge kits, etc. While some of the info is still applicable of course, that version was published just as cars were switching to R134a from R12. This 2011 version still covers that conversion, but. It gives enough information that you can proceed without always having a schematic or a step by step, connect the dots, diagram. 



Had to watch youtube witch was great. serioysly i dont ewer by a manual from Haynes. crap manuals You could tell then, it was written by competent experienced people. I picked up the idea of repairing my VW T4 myself and, bought a manual again 40 years later and it is a disaster. After repairing cars, trucks and agricultural machines, studying to become a senior civil engineer, after a lifelong career, experienced from constructing machines and vehicles of all kinds, writing technical manuals, I can get by doing the work from my own experience. But for those who need guidance will have a tough job with that little aid Haynes manual provide. I can only state that Haynes has completely ruined their once prestigious brand. I contacted Haynes Aust and was brushed. Very dissapointed The newer stuff is fine and the fresh ideas on various subject are a change from car and motorcycle repair manuals. Possibly, we dont DIY repair as much as we all used to do, back in the depth of time When I started working on cars, Haynes manuals never used to like this. I had a major shock when the wiring diagrams for Petrol and Diesel ECUs were not included. Yes, I do feel ripped off. Yes. This will be the last Haynes manual I purchase. The online book works. Then you go to toilet and when you come back you are signed off.



Then you need to go to their normal web site, sign in, and click thru 5 pages to finally get back to the manual!!!!!!!!!! The information is generally poor. There is 10 pages how to change the oil but NOT a word about special tool I needed for remove internal drive shaft. Just REMOVE THE DRIVE SHAFT. Not a single word about the thread inside, NOTHING. Paper is low quality, it will get dirty quickly. They should use waxed paper. Btw while submitting there was no information that I get the permission only for ONE year. The online is good for traveling. It seemed very simple. Book arrived and although it says Yaris and the model years cover 2007, the book proved useless. Apparently I am at fault for buying it because somewhere it mentions it is an Aus version. But then why the f does their system say it is for my 2007 UK Yaris. I've also been told that there is some commonality between the cars. So I guess the book is only wrong about 50% of the time. Contacted them again and they really think it is acceptable to sell a book which is not for the car that matches the registration. I also have no idea why they don't just apologise when they sell the wrong book. That was the last of about 20 over the years Haynes manual I shall buy. The images should be colour, the bike manual images with inherently smaller parts are at times very difficult to make out. However it does not cover the engine in my car. The website does not make it clear which engines are covered, just the engine sizes which in this case is not adequate there were different 1.3L engines over the years. I am awaiting a returns reference from them, and expect them to refund my return postage as it is their failing. The manual itself, which is still shrinkwrapped, is a thin flimsy paperback. I was in two minds whether to buy the printed book or get the online version. Online is 14 per book PER YEAR so I opted for the book. When I received it, I was gutted by the quality. It will not last long.

Pity the online version is not for life like the book, that way I would invest but I am not going to rent a book for 12 months and to be honest, I don't think I will buy another, I will seek out a photocopied version! Half of the tasks don't have any pictures, and any videos have got Americans on them horrible and are working on cars with left hand drive. Not even remotely concise, and a nightmare to find when you get to the Hays website. Terrible, wouldn't ever buy a Haynes again. And to think, the

subscription is only for a year. There are missing steps and some procedures over simplified. e.g. Peugeot 207 cylinder head cannot be removed with the inlet manifold insitu as stated as it prevents removal of the inlet camshaft housing. Also no mention of the drive shaft preventing removal of a lower suspension arm bolt. A competent DIY person will work around these omissions but it adds time to discover and resolve. Good for torque wrench settings though. This wouldn't have been an issue however I paid the same price for this short subscription as I would have paid for a paper copy which I could keep for life. I will aim to never use them again if I can help it as this is just a rip off. Incorrect runout values. Missing steps in repair procedures. Poor.
